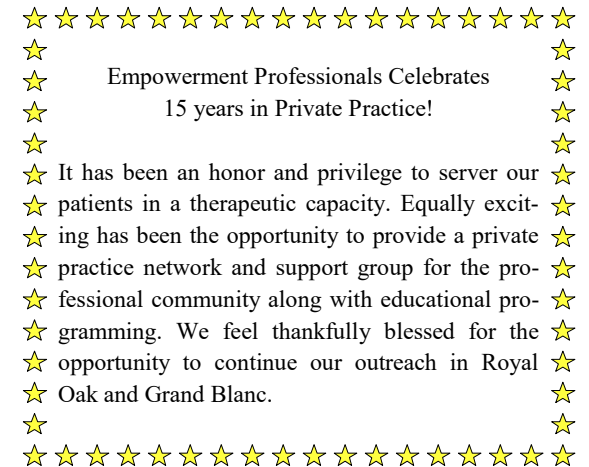
Beverly J Patchett, LMSW, DCSW, ICAADC
